

## CODE OF CONDUCT NAMEF OFFICIALS

his Code of Conduct applies to NAMEF officials at all times when attending or judging at competitions.

This document should be read in conjunction with the current NAMEF Rules and the FEI Code of Conduct.

- Respect the rights, dignity and worth of others
- Be fair, equitable, considerate and honest in all dealing with others
- Use facilities and equipment for their proper purposes and care for and maintain such facilities and equipment correctly
- Refrain from anything which may abuse, intimidate or harass others
- Provide a safe environment for training and competition
- Place the safety and welfare of the riders/participants above all else
- Abide by the principles of the FEI Code of Conduct for the Welfare of the Horse
- Maintain a 'duty of care' towards others and an accountability for matters relating to training and competition
- Accept responsibility for all actions taken
- Be impartial
- Avoid any situation which may lead to a conflict of interest
- Be courteous, respectful and open to discussion and interaction
- Value the individual in sport
- Preserve and protect the standing and reputation of the organisation/National Federation
- Understand the repercussions if you breach the rules of the NF, or are aware of any breaches of the rules of the National Federation, without reporting it.
- Provide a safe environment for the conduct of the activity.
- Be a positive role model.
