## **Equine Influenza vaccinations for 2014 and beyond**

NAMEF will apply the FEI Rules & Regulations for the FEI vaccinations as of this year. Due to the many FEI shows our riding community will enjoy this year, a decision to apply the FEI rules for Equine Influenza as of January 2014 is applicable. NAMEF requires all participating horses to be up to date with their AHS vaccinations annually as well. Please ensure to be up to date with your vaccinations to avoid disappointment.

## **Horse Passport Controls:**

Strict passport controls will be implemented at NAMEF shows as of 2014. No or incomplete passport(s) will result in being banned from the show immediately. Dr Anna Marais has kindly agreed to be available whenever possible for all Show Organizers to oversee the Passport controls.
