- Jumping competition over 2 rounds, height at 1,10m spread 1,30m, 350mpm
- Dressage competition DSA test are **Novice 6** and **Elementary 1**
- Equitation competition will be **Equitation Team Test**, height 1,00m

### Triangle rein

**In South Africa the Pony riders in Preliminary tests are allowed the following:**

To assist in the improvement of the dressage seat and understanding of the correct frame, we have decided to follow in the footsteps of our German counterparts and the South African counterparts and introduce the Triangle Rein for the very earliest level of dressage.

PLEASE SEE THE ATTACHED CIRCULAR which gives some more information for riders/trainers/judges on the use of the triangle rein.

The use of this rein will not be compulsory at any stage, but may be used for Lead Rein tests, SAEA Pony Riders Prelim tests and SANESA tests below the level of SAEA tests.

*"For too long we have been watching hollow unhappy ponies with riders bouncing on stiff backs, trying to pull their ponies round. The use of the Triangle Rein is aimed at improving the comfort of the ponies and the riding techniques of their riders."*

It will be up to the judges of the classes to ensure that the triangle rein never causes discomfort to the pony in any way and that the pony is not pulled behind the vertical by the use of the rein.
